







BY 2100 1 IN 3 EUROPEANS WILL BE OVER 65






Population pyramids, EU 2009 and 2024 (% of the total population)




Meaning of the team

The frail elderly person at a social and health level presents complex problems that therefore require a group approach.

Teamwork means that the care is carried out by an "integrated" group, that is, by people who work harmoniously with each other and who influence their task through a continuous correlation made of exchanges, comparisons, contributions, suggestions, opinions ...

It was 2012, the European year of active ageing and solidarity between generations






The Value of Intergenerational Dialogue

- Benefits both young people and older adults
- Digitalization and fast-paced life widen the generational gap
- Risk: losing connection across generations
- Solution: structured and intentional intergenerational dialogue

What Is Intergenerational Dialogue?

- A bridge between generations through mutual exchange
- Often modeled on grandparent-grandchild relationships
- Children lack support; older adults have time and experience
- Takes place in families, communities, schools, and institutions



Elderly people and Loneliness: A Growing Concern

- Individualism and digital life weaken social bonds
- Loneliness is a health risk: linked to cognitive decline and disease
- Intergenerational contact combats isolation and depression
- Mutual benefits: energy vs. wisdom, curiosity vs. reflection

Benefits for Children and Adolescents

- Emotional and psychological support
- Acquisition of values and life skills
- Improved social interaction and empathy
- Development of critical thinking
- Positive views of aging

Benefits for Older Adults

- Reduced loneliness and depression
- Enhanced physical and emotional well-being
- Renewed sense of purpose
- Connection to current trends and technology
- Boosted self-esteem and confidence

Implementing Intergenerational Exchange: Practical Approaches

- In family and community settings: often spontaneous
- In care settings: must be intentionally designed
- Examples:
 - o Creative workshops
 - o Gardening and cooking
 - o Walks, games, technology use
 - o Community events

Role of the social and health Educator

- Create safe and inclusive spaces
- Plan time and resources effectively
- Define goals and outcomes
- Encourage participation
- Evaluate and adapt
 - Be open to spontaneity and human connection

Case Study – Children & Elders with Dementia

- Project by OIC Foundation (Italy)
- Participants:
 - o 7 elders with dementia
 - o 14 preschool children
 - o Multidisciplinary team
- Key questions:

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- o How to manage energy, fragility, behaviors?
 - How to overcome stereotypes and biases?

Outcomes of the Case Study

- Focus on emotional connection, not performance
- Safe, simple, emotionally rich spaces
- Elders change when children are present
- Children gain confidence and empathy
- Deep, moving, human connection occurs
